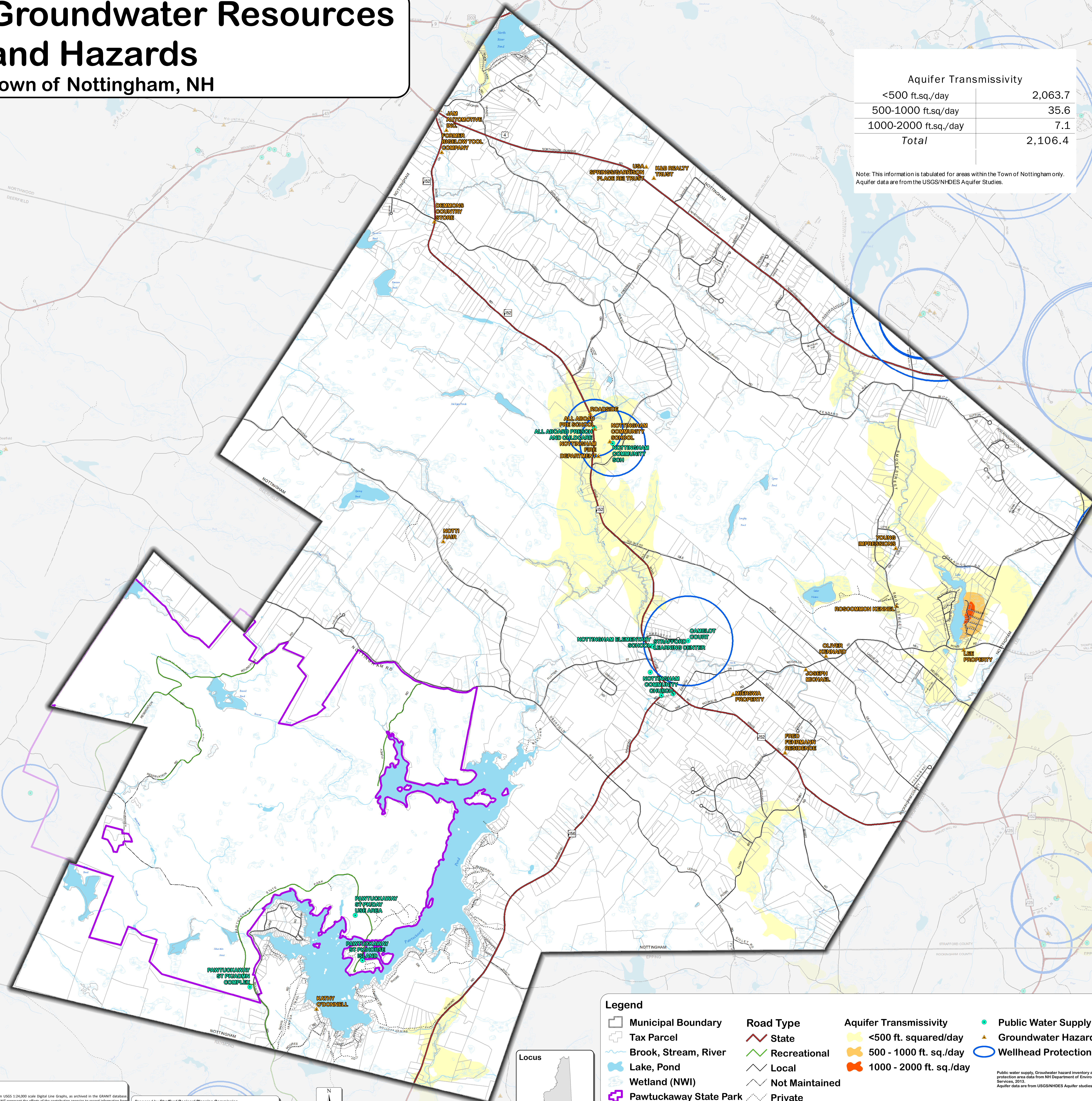

Data Sources

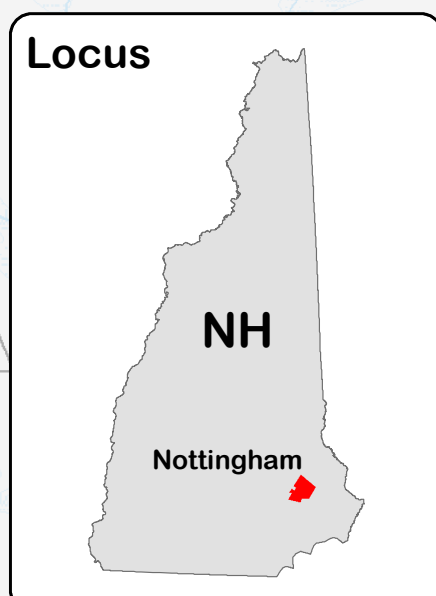
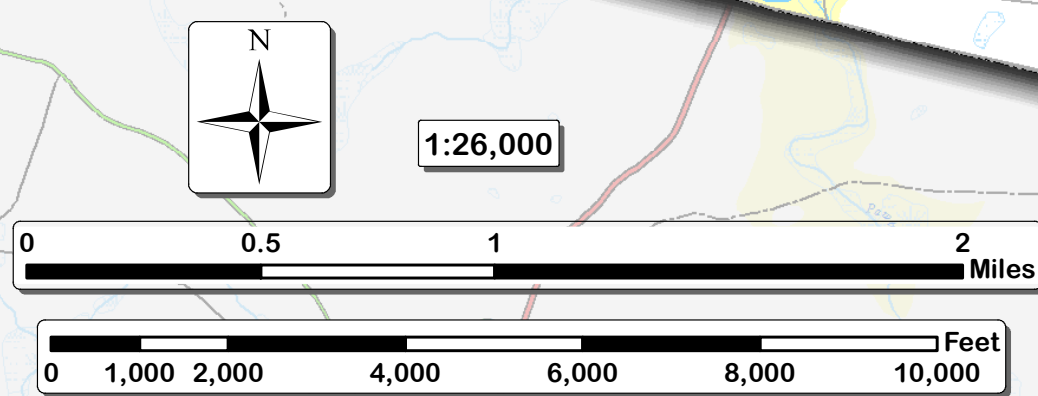
