- 2 Minutes of the October 19, 2021 meeting were approved as distributed.
- 3 School submissions were reviewed, and essentially fall into two scenarios the School Board is
- 4 still developing a proposal for School District meeting, one a building addition and one adding
- 5 modular classrooms. CIP plans will be driven by that decision. Tony asked Megan to get
- 6 clarification on the years listed on the CIP sheets for the School proposals, since they were out of
- 7 sequence.
- 8 Town department submissions were reviewed individually. Topics with extended discussion
- 9 included: a 2nd ambulance for the FD, radios, Tasers and cruiser cameras for the PD, highway
- trucks; an automated beach gate; tv/internet meeting broadcasts; and recycling center equipment.
- Some of these were small value purchases and not significant capital expenses and could
- potentially be folded into the operating budget. Chris noted that the Select Board is still working
- on initial budget drafts and has not reviewed CIP proposals in depth yet.

 - Tony to update the CIP spreadsheet with the information currently available, and distribute.
