Town Administrator Report

- 31 Mr. Sterndale said they received the tax rate. It's better than what they spoke about 2 weeks ago.
- 32 It is \$22.50 per \$1000, down from last year by \$0.14. There was a large school surplus which is
- why the tax rate is lower. Mr. Bartlett asked what the return was from the school last year. Mr.
- 34 Sterndale said this year it's approximately \$706k but last year it was around \$306k. The biggest
- driver on the town side was the veteran tax credit which was around \$117k. Holiday parade is
- December 7. The BOS will hand out candy in the parade. Fire department invited BOS to their
- 37 Christmas party. New Hope church has an invite as well for the BOS. The town applied to the
- 38 state for a grant for a service to inventory storm assets, culverts, etc. They are going to ask at
- town meeting for the money but the town will get it reimbursed in the end.

- 41 Tax Deed Waivers
- 42 A policy was created a few months ago regarding tax deed waivers. There is a process once
- someone doesn't pay for 3 years. The major reasons for waiving are: value isn't that big (dollars
- owed or property value), a property may be sold (then the town will get paid anyway), liabilities
- on the property.
- 46 Mr. Morin commented if someone is asking for double the property assessment, the property will
- likely not sell so the BOS will likely be in the same boat next year with this property. Mr.
- 48 Sterndale went over the sheet with properties listed.
