- how it will affect wildlife and other houses. There is 40 acres on one property, and there is 24
- 79 acres on another property that were both recently sold. She asked how the residents on Stevens
- 80 Hill Road could go about protecting the land. Ms. Smith said she should go to the meetings
- 81 when they discuss the potential subdivisions and also become knowledgeable about conservation
- 82 commissions.
