8 Mr. Bartlett opened the meeting at 9:00 AM.

Opening Statement

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12 Mr. Bartlett stated the Board would be entering into a non-public session but before they begin,

they have a prepared statement, and he will now be turning it over to Selectman Matt Shirland to present.

Mr. Shirland stated the Selectmen received the initial complaint regarding the Fire Department in a non-public session on March 20, 2023, at which time 6 members of the department came before the Board of Selectmen to bring forth allegations dealing with conduct and issues with the Nottingham Fire-Rescue Department. The following is the timeline of subsequent events:

• March 23, 2023 – The Fire Chief and Lieutenant were placed on Paid Administrative Leave

- March 31, 2023 The investigation into the complaint starting in turn a fair and impartial investigation to take place
- April 3, 2023-May 1, 2023 –13 interviews were conducted
- May 22, 2023 Fire Chief interviewed
- May 25, 2023 Lieutenant interviewed
- May 26, 2023 The last of the 13 interviewees took place
- All interviews happened between April 3 and May 26
- The following two weeks, the investigator compiled her findings from all interviews conducted into a report
- The Board met with the Town's Attorney to review a summary of the findings from the investigation
- June 19, 2023 The Board held a non-public session to review the investigator's report, in preparation for release of the information in a redacted version.

Mr. Shirland summarized how a typical investigation process is handled. Once an allegation has been filed against an individual, the employer places the individual on paid administrative leave to conduct an investigation into the allegation, the investigation is then completed, and that is where they are at currently, at the conclusion of the fact-finding stage of the investigation process.

Mr. Dabrieo clarified that they did not receive a copy of the report during their meeting with the attorney; it was only a review of the information the attorney had received.

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Mr. Bartlett asked if there were any further questions or comments from the other board members.

Being none, he then reiterated that the Fire Chief and Lieutenant were placed on paid administrative leave, not suspended as some have conveyed.
