**Public Hearing** 

Case #P15-005-LLA – Application from Eric C. Mitchell & Assoc. Inc. for Maverick Development Corp. to adjust the lot line between lots 1-3 &1-4 on Tax Map 15. The properties are located at 66 &68 Garland Road, Nottingham NH and are owned by Maverick Development Corp.

Chris Hickey informed the Board of the plans for the Lot Line Adjustment.

Mr. Koutelis explained to the Board his plans:

He owns property on either side of the Nottingham/Epping town lines. He wants to use the town line to be the boundary line between his current house lot and the lot he plans to use to build another home. He is seeking guidance from the board. The land in Nottingham would be a non-conforming lot with the town line as the boundary line. The

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consideration is whether the Koutelis' apply to the ZBA for a variance or the non-conforming lot be grandfathered. Mr. Colby referenced RSA 674:3 and added that by law the 5.62 acres for lot 4-A in Nottingham has a boundary line dividing it from Epping. The tax card lists it as a lot since 1987. It is a nonconforming lot due to the lack of 30ft of frontage.

The Board suggested the Koutelis' apply for a Variance to have evidence of the acceptance of the lot as is before building.
