• Sign Impact Fee Update agreement

Mr. Colby gave the Board a brief update per the agreement. (Agreement attached) Discussion:

The Board requested a timeline be added to the agreement prior to signing it.

No public hearing on the Impact Fees is necessary unless the fees figures change.

The Board can vote to remove the Impact Fee section from the Zoning Ordinance. If the Board votes to do that then it would be voted on at the March 2016 Town Elections.

At a previous meeting it was stated that the Fire Department bond is almost paid up. That was stated in error, the Bond will be paid off in 2027.

Much of the School's CIP doesn't apply to the agreed on uses for their Impact Fees. The only one mentioned was for Modular's for the proposed all-day Kindergarten.

The Board agreed to table the discussion until after the CIP figures.

The timeline agreed on: Start date upon Board's signing- finish by June 1, 2016.

• Discuss estimate for adding Recreation, Public Works and Police Department The Board requested to have the estimate (Attached) e-mailed to them the next day. The estimate stated that Public Works and the Police Department did not appear to be feasible. However, Recreation may be feasible.

If applying a Recreation Impact Fee is justifiable a Public Hearing will be scheduled fees would start being collected July 2017.

The Planning Board would like to have a meeting with the School Board per their use of the Marston property.

The Board requested legal counsel be contacted regarding possible use of School Impact Fees toward the Marston property.

- Continued discussion: Zoning Ordinance definition changes for March Election The Board agreed to table defining Agriculture until 2016 due to bills in the legislation regarding Agriculture. The Board also recognized that other additional Agricultural activities need to be defined as well such as:
  - Agribusiness
  - Agritourism
  - Aquaculture

The Board agreed to omit Animal feedlot and Campground from the Zoning Ordinance Definitions.

The Board agreed to table defining Designated Area until 2016.

**Motion made by:** Ms. Andersen to "accept the definition changes made to Zoning Ordinances as defined and the recommendations to omit Animal feedlot and Campground and to hold off on the Designated area and Agriculture."
