ORDER ON PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND PRELIMINARY STRUCTURING ORDER

The plaintiff filed a Complaint seeking declaratory judgment and a preliminary and permanent injunction to prevent the enforcement of a newly enacted Nottingham town ordinance entitled "Freedom From Chemical Trespass Rights-Based Ordinance." The Town has not objected to the entry of a preliminary injunction. The Town is enjoined from enforcing the "Freedom From Chemical Trespass Rights-Based Ordinance" pending further order from this Court on the merits of the Complaint.

The Court met with counsel for both parties as well as counsel for potential intervenors in the matter today. The Town will file an Answer to the complaint and the parties will submit a joint proposed structuring order pursuant to the deadlines set forth in court rules. To the extent that any person or organization not named in the Complaint wishes to intervene pursuant to N.H. R. Civ. P. 15, a motion to intervene must be filed by the deadline for the Town's Answer. The named parties will have 10 days to
