Dear Planning Board Members:

This letter is to inform the town of Nottingham that Eversource is requesting the approval to complete scheduled maintenance trimming on various scenic roads in Nottingham. These roads include Case Rd, Gile Rd – dirt portion, Ledge Farm Rd, Mitchell Rd – dirt portion from Pole 875/32 westward, and Poor Farm Rd. This work is necessary to ensure the safe distribution of power and improve reliability of electric service for our customers.

According to Eversource records, the above listed roads are scenic roads for the Town of Nottingham. Please consider this letter to be a request from Eversource for a public hearing for the purpose of trimming, pursuant to RSA 231:158. This information will be presented to the board. Please inform this office of the date, time, and place of said meeting so that we may have a representative present.

All work will be performed by Northern Tree service, and in accordance with accepted arboriculture standards. The mandated trimming specifications require clearance 8 feet to the side of primary conductors, 10 feet below primary conductors, and 15 feet above primary conductors.

Eversource requires that our contractors contact each landowner where trees are to be trimmed prior to commencement of work on that property. Individual concerns will be addressed at this time.
