

Town of Nottingham Holiday Parade PARADE RULES AND LIABILITY FORMS

GENERAL PARADE RULES:

- This event is ALWAYS held on the first Saturday in December.
- This event is RAIN OR SHINE. Please dress accordingly.
- Walking, driving, bike riding, scooters, skateboarding, dancing, and general merriment allowed.
- Smoking, alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, firearms, mopeds, segways, and 4wheelers are prohibited.
- Bicyclists and scooters must wear a helmet and have lights/reflective materials on the bicycle for safety.
- Equines, bovines, or any other animals may not be left unattended and must be followed by a clean-up crew.
- Children must have adult supervision before, during and at the end of the parade. State law also requires there be at least one adult for every four children riding on a float.
- All vehicle operators must possess a valid driver's license and registration for the vehicle.
- Each entry application has a maximum of 2 vehicles.

FLOATS:

No floats or towed trailers with wheels protruding beyond the footprint of the float platform will be <u>allowed</u>. No exposed wheel. Fenders are not sufficient. Be sure your float includes a platform that extends out farther than the wheels. If you have questions, please call 603-679-3435.

- All groups need to either be all walking or all on a float. Due to safety concerns of the Nottingham Police Department, we cannot allow walkers to walk beside their floats. Walkers will be at the beginning of the parade and floats and vehicles will follow.
- Participants SHALL NOT get on or off moving floats and walking participants SHALL NOT retrieve articles from floats.
- Portable generators must be securely mounted. Floats should be constructed with fire-retardant materials and must carry an all-purpose type ABC, 5-lb. fire extinguisher within reach of the driver. No open flames permitted.
- At least one adult, other than the driver, must supervise children riding in vehicles and have reasonable means of immediate communication with the driver. There "shall not be less than one adult per every 4 children and sufficient to ensure each child is visible to a supervising adult," per RSA 265:108-a.
- All participants on floats must be seated with a substantial barrier in front of them; sitting on the edge of the vehicle/float with arms and legs hanging off is prohibited. STANDING ON FLOATS IN PROHIBITED.
- ALL FLOAT must submit 3 things- Please email <u>recreation@nottingham-nh.gov</u>
 - Picture of trailer (Make sure that wheels are not exposed)
 - o Proof of registration & insurance for trailer
 - Copy of driver's license of the driver of the float or vehicle.

LIABILITY RELEASE:

- Applicants assume all responsibility for any loss or damage in connection with their participation in the parade. The Town of Nottingham will not be liable for any damage, theft, loss of property, or injury.
- The Town of Nottingham reserves the right to remove any entry where safety measures are, in the opinion of Town staff, inadequate and the right to disqualify any entry for failure to abide by safety regulations.
- The ultimate responsibility for safety lies with each parade participant. Participants must comply
 with these rules and follow all other applicable government laws and regulations, safety codes,
 manufacturer's recommendations, and similar standards necessary to safely operate vehicles,
 floats and other equipment.

ROUTE:

- 9:15AM- All Walkers will line up at the Town Hall.
- 9:15AM- All Floats and Vehicles will line up at the Town Highway Garage on Flutter Street.
- The parade starts promptly at 10:00AM.
- Parade lineup will be sent out a few days prior to the event.

BEGINNING AND END:

- Beginning: Everyone must be in their place at 9:45AM.
 - o All entries must be checked in with a Parks and Rec Staff Member.
 - No Float or vehicle may be left unattended while waiting for the parade to begin.
 - The award judging will take place prior to the start of the parade.
- End: Upon arrival at the town hall parking lot, ALL WALKERS must go straight onto the baseball field to get out of the way of floats and vehicles. Floats and vehicles can turn down Flutter Street if they are not dropping off or unloading people. If floats and vehicles need to unload people, they will pull into the Town Hall parking lot.

CANDY:

Entries may hand out candy and souvenirs along the parade route, but **NO ONE MAY TOSS OR THROW ANYTHING INTO THE CROWD. Violators will be removed from the parade.**

FEES:

- Nonprofit, community organizations and businesses, family, students, neighborhood group- No Fee!
- Nonresident Group or corporate organizations- \$35.00 (Cash or Check made out to the Town of Nottingham).

AWARDS:

- Best Community Float Entry
- Most Creative Walking Group Entry
- Nottingham Parks and Rec Award



November 27- Deadline for all other entries.



November 29- No entries are allowed from this point forward.
