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- 9 The ZBA held a Site Walk for the following case:
- 10 Case 20-014-VA- Application from Robert Diberto requesting a Variance from Article III
- 11 Section B.4 of the Nottingham Zoning Ordinance to permit filling 6,717 SF of a PF01/4eg
- 12 wetland as part of the road construction for a proposed subdivision. The property is located on
- 13 Mitchell Road in Nottingham, NH and is identified as Tax Map 7 Lot 1 Sublot N.
- 14 Those in attendance met on Mitchell Road between 102 Mitchell Road and 2 Sutton Street in
- 15 Nottingham NH.
- Mr. Berry and Mr. Hayden of Berry Surveying guided the group into the woods, on the parcel for
- the proposed Subdivision, to the location of the two (2) wetland dredge and fill sites. The
- purpose of the Site Walk was to provide a clearer understanding of the wetland size and type in a
- 19 visual manner.
- The Board members asked several questions to gain further understanding. They learned that the locations:
 - Are relatively small in area as delineated by the flagging on site
 - Appeared dry (no pooling of water where we stepped)
 - Were slightly low areas in terms of grade
 - Not considered "high value wetlands"
 - Members were informed that these locations were purposely chosen in an effort to avoid the more "valued wetlands" on site
 - The disturbance areas are designed in an effort to prevent increased run-off downstream from the subdivision and areas of "more valued" wetland on site were avoided
- Those present expressed satisfaction with the Site Walk and what was learned.
